Duration of Package: 14 or 15 Days (Tempo Traveler)

- Day 01 Board **Rajdhani Express (12301)** / or any suitable train from Hwh Station at **04:50 P: M** for New Delhi.
- Day 02 Reach New Delhi Station at 10:05 A:M (**Refreshment at New Delhi Railway Waiting Hall for few hours**) and same day board Jammu Rajdhani (12425) at 08:40 P:M. for Jammu.
- Day 03 Reach **Jammu** around **05:00 A:M** and transfer to **Hotel (A.C)** (**Check in time 12.00 Noon**). After Evening snacks and tea visit **Raghunath Temple** (By Walk) [**Raghunath Temple has been dedicated to Lord Rama who is one of the primary Hindu deities. The temple was constructed by Maharaja Gulab Singh who was the founder of kingdom of Jammu & Kashmir and the work on the temple began in 1835 A.D. After his death the work was completed by Maharaja Gulab Singh's son, Maharaja Ranbir Singh. The main temple's inner wall is covered with gold sheet on the three sides of the temple. The temple also has a vast gallery which has various "lingams" as well as "saligrams" that are placed for the general public as well.**]. Night stay at **Jammu**.
- Day 04 With packed breakfast at **05:30 A.M**, Start for **Srinagar** via **Chenani Nashri Tunnel** (It is the **second longest road tunnel in India with a length of 9.28 km (30,446.2 ft)**. Lunch, evening snacks and tea will be served on the way (Local Dhaba). Reach **Srinagar** in the evening and transfer to hotel (**A.C**). Night stay at **Srinagar**.
- Day 05 After breakfast at **08:00 A.M**. visit [**Shankaracharya Temple or Jyeshtheshwara Temple is a Hindu temple situated on top of the Shankaracharya Hill on the Zabarwan Range in Srinagar in the Indian union territory of Jammu and Kashmir. It is dedicated to the Hindu god, Shiva. The temple is at a height of 1,000 feet (300 m) above the valley**]. (from temple parking you have to walk approx 2 K.M / or by local Transport cost borne by Tousist). Return to hotel for lunch. After lunch visit **Mughal Gardens (Shalimarbag, Nishatbag)** Night stay at **Srinagar (A.C)**.
- Day 06 After breakfast at 08:00 a.m. start for **Gulmarg**. [**Gulmarg known as Gulmarag lit meadow of flowers in Kashmiri, is a hill station, tourist destination, skiing destination, and a notified area committee in the Baramulla district in the Indian union territory of Jammu and Kashmir It is located at a distance 49 km from Srinagar. The town is situated in the Pir Panjal Range in the Western Himalayas and lies within the boundaries of Gulmarg**] Packed lunch will be served at Gulmarg (from Gulmarg parking you have to walk approx 2 K.M / or by local Transport cost borne by Tousist). **The cable car ride at Gulmarg is subject to availability. If you choose to avail of this ride, it is optional and the cost will be borne by the tourists themselves. Tickets must be purchased online through the official website: (<https://www.jammukashmircablecar.com/>) Please note that we cannot arrange or provide tickets for the cable car ride.** Return to Srinagar in the evening and night stay **Srinagar (A.C)**.
- Day 07 After breakfast 08:00 A:M start for **Doodhpathri valley** [**Doodhpathri lies in a bowl shaped valley in the Pir Panjal Range of the Himalayas, at an altitude of 2,730 m (8,957 ft) above sea level**] (entry tkt. and other activities optional at your own cost). Return to Srinagar in the evening and **Sikara Ride (optional at your own cost)** night stay on **Srinagar (A.C)**.
- Day 08 After breakfast start for **Sonamarg** at 08:00 A:M [**Sonamarg had historical significance as a gateway on the ancient Silk Road, connecting Kashmir with Tibet. Today, the hill station is a popular tourist destination amongst fishers and hikers. It is located 80 kilometres northeast of the capital city, Srinagar**]. on the way visit Kheerbhawani Durga Temple, lunch will be served at Sonamarg. (**Zero Point / Snow Point - Horse Ride/Car Ride cost to be bourne by passenger**). Return to Sonamarg in the evening and night stay at **Hotel**.

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- Day 09 After breakfast start for **Pahelgam**, [**Pahalgam village of shepherds' in Kashmiri is near Anantnag city in the Anantnag district of the Indian-administered union territory of Jammu and Kashmir. It is a popular tourist destination and hill station. Its lush green meadows and pristine waters attract thousands of tourists from all over the world each year. It is located 90 kilometres from Srinagar on the banks of Lidder River at an altitude of 7,200 feet. Pahalgam is associated with the annual pilgrimage to the shrine Amarnath Yatra. Chandanwari, located 16 kilometres (9.9 mi) from Pahalgam. Lunch will be served on the way (local Dhaba), reach Pahelgam in the evening and transfer to Hotel. Tea and snacks at Hotel. Night stay at Pahelgam.**
- Day 10 After breakfast visit **Chandanwari and Betebwari (Betebwari entry Tkt. at your own cost) .(Aru Valley Optional)** Lunch at hotel and afternoon free for leisure. Night stay at Pahelgam.
- Day 11: With packed breakfast at 06:00 A.M. start for **Katra**. Lunch will be served on the way (Pure Veg) Reach **Katra** in the evening and transfer to **Hotel (A.C Star category)**. Vaishnodevi Darshan at night (Self Visit).(**Dandy,Ponny if availed will be borne by the Tourists**). [**Vaishno Devi also known as Mata Rani, Trikuta, Ambe and Vaishnavi**] is a manifestation of the Hindu mother goddess Lakshmi in some beliefs. Vaishno Devi is worshipped as a combined avatar of the goddesses Mahakali, Mahalakshmi, and Mahasarasvati. Additionally, she is seen as the potency of Hari or Vishnu. Vaishnavi is the worshipper of Vishnu who meditates to him on the Trikuta mountain and awaits his arrival The Vaishno Devi Temple is an important Hindu temple dedicated to Vaishno Devi located in Katra at the Trikuta Mountains within the Indian Union territory of Jammu and Kashmir. The temple is one of the 108 Shakti Peethas dedicated to Durga, who is worshipped as Vaishno Devi It is one of the most visited pilgrimage centers of India. Every year millions of visitors visit the temple During festivals like Navaratri, the count even increases to ten million (one crore) visitors.] Night stay at Katra (A.C).
- Day 12 **Mata Vaishnodevi darsan by Helicopter or Battery car (Ardhkuwari to Bhawan 6km) subject to availability if availed is optional and will be borne by the Tourists by online Tkt. www.maavaishnodevi.org / www.maavaishnadevi.net.** Return from Vaishnodevi Darshan in the morning and full day free for rest. Night stay at Katra (A.C).

Option 1: (Day-13-14-15)

Checkout from hotel: 11:30 A:M, After Lunch: 02:30 PM. Travel to Jammu Arrival at **Jammu Railway Station**: You'll arrive and take a few hours' rest at the Jammu Railway Waiting Hall.

Board **Rajdhani Express (12426)** at 09:25 PM from **Jammu** for **New Delhi**.

After reaching New Delhi, board the **Rajdhani Express (12302)** at 04:50 PM for Howrah.

Option 2: (day-13-14)

• **Travel from Katra:** Take **Vande Bharat Express (22478)** from **Katra** at 05:50 AM for New Delhi, which reaches New Delhi at 02:00 PM. And same day board the **Rajdhani Express (12302)** at 04:50 PM for Howrah.
