DAY 01	Check and meet at Hotel. Full day rest.	SRINAGAR
DAY 02	After Breakfast start for KARGIL 201km. On the way visit ZOJILA PASS (11,575 ft.), Kargil War Memorial (Also known as DRAS WAR MEMORIAL, is a War Memorial built by the Indian Army. Commemorating the 1999 Kargil War between India and Pakistan.), Reach Kargil at Evening and transfer to hotel.	KARGIL
DAY 03	After Breakfast start for LEH 216km. On the way visit Mulbek Buddha Statue (It is believed to be built around 800 years ago by the students of great Tibetan scholar Lotsawa Rinchen Zampo, Moon Land, Lamayuru, Magnetic Hill gravity hill located near Leh. surrounding slopes create the optical illusion of hill. & GURDWARA PATHAR SAHIB (about 25km away from Leh. On the Leh Kargil Road 12000ft. The Gurdwara was built in 1517 to commemorate the visit to the region of Guru Nanak Dev, the founder Guru of the Sikh faith.) Night stay at LEH.	LEH
DAY 04	After Breakfast visit Local Sight Seeing. <u>THIKSE MONASTERY</u> : The Monastery have many items of Buddhist Art such as Stupas, Statues, Thangkas, wall paintings and swords. One of the main points of interest is the MAITREYA Temple installed to commemorate the visit of the 14th Dalai Lama to this Monastery in 1970 it contains a 49 ft. height statue in Ladakh, covering two storeyed of the building. <u>SHEY PALACE</u> : Shey Palace & Monastery were built in 1655 on the instructions of Delden Namgyal. In the memory of his Late father, Sengge Namgyal. The Monastery is noted for its giant copper with gilded gold statue of seated Shakyamuni Buddha. It is said to be the second largest such Statue in Ladakh. <u>LEH PALACE</u> : Leh Palace is a former royal Palace overlooking the city of Leh. It was constructed circa 1600 by Sengge Namgyal. <u>SANTI STUPA</u> : Santi Stupa is a Buddhist white-domed stupa (Chorten) on a hilltop in Chanspa, Leh. It was built in 1991 by Japanese Buddhist Bhikshu, Gyomyo Nakamura and past of the Peace Pagoda mission.	LEH

DAY 05	After Breakfast Drive to Nubra Vally (120 km) via KHARDUNGLA PASS (17,582 Ft.) The road is one of the World's highest Motorable road. Reach Nubra afternoon and check in hotel. Evening visit DISKIT MONASTERY, also known as Diskit Gompa is the oldest and largest Buddhist Monastery in the Nubra Vally. <u>BUDDHA STATUE</u> : 33 meter statue of Maitreya Buddha near Diskit Monastery facing down the Shyak River towards Nubra Vally. Overnight stay at Nubra.	NUBRA
DAY 06	After Breakfast visit TURTUK (100km). It is a small village close to the Line of Control between INDIA and PAKISTHAN. These villages from the only region in INDIA populated by BALTIC people (origin in Pakistan) <u>HUNDER VALLY</u> : Nubra Vally in Ladakh, one can find Bactrain camels (Double humps). Far from a desert, the region is at an altitude of around 10,000ft above sea level. Night stay at Nubra Vally	NUBRA
DAY 07	After Breakfast Start for PANGONG – TSO (150km). On the way visit Shyok River. Reach Pangong-Tso at afternoon and transfer to hotel. Night stay at Pangong (Wooden Cottage/Tent) <u>PANGONG - TSO</u> : Is an Endorheic Lake spanning eastern Ladakh and west Tibet situated at an elevation of 13,862ft. and 134km long. Approximately 50% of the overall Lake lies with in Tibet in China, 40% in Ladakh, India and the remaining 10% is disputed is a de-facto buffer zone between India and China.	PANGONG
DAY 08	After Breakfast start for Hanle. Reach Hanle at noon. After lunch visit highest optical telescope in the world. Night stay at Hanle.	HANLE
DAY 09	After Breakfast start for Leh. On the visit TSO-MORIRI. Reach Leh at evening and transfer to Hotel. <u>TSO-MORIRI</u> : The Lake is at an altitude of 14,836 ft. It is the largest of the high altitude. It is about 26km. North to South in length and 3 to 5 km. wide. <u>HEMIS MONASTERY</u> : Hemis Monastery is a Himalayan Buddhist Gompa of the Drukpa Linege, in Hemis. It was re-established in 1672 by the Ladhaki King Singge Namgyal.	LEH
DAY 10	Full day free for leisure . Night stay at Leh.	LEH
DAY 11	Early morning start for Jispa (357k.m) via Tang Lang La(17,582ft), Pang Vally, Baralacha La Pass etc . Reach Jispa (10,500ft).	JISPA
DAY 12	After breakfast start for Manali via ATAL TUNEL (71K.M) on the way visit confluence of Chandra and Bhaga River near Tandi Sarai, reach Manali at afternoon evening is free , night stay at MANALI	MANALI
DAY 13	After breakfast start for Chandigarh (287k.m) lunch on the way reach Chandighr at evening , dinner also seave Chandigarh and Board NETAJI EXP (12312) AT 01:25 A:M for HOWRAH	TRAIN
