DAY 01:

DAY 02:

COLOMBO – PINNAWALA(3hrs) – ANURADHAPURA (4hrs)

After breakfast leave to PINNAWALA

A visit to Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage is a memorable experience for tourists who want to see elephants up close in a natural setting. Located near Kegalle, this sanctuary allows visitors to observe a large herd of elephants being cared for, fed, and bathed. One of the highlights is watching the elephants walk together to the river and enjoy their bath, which usually happens twice a day and attracts many visitors.

Then heading towards ANURADHAPURA (4hrs)

Afterwards do the City Tour (Jaya Sri Maha Bodhi & The Ruwanweli Maha Seya) in Anuradhapura.

Anuradhapura, is a major city in Sri Lanka. It is the capital city of North Central Province, Sri Lanka and the capital of Anuradhapura District. Anuradhapura is one of the ancient capitals of Sri Lanka, famous for its well-preserved ruins of ancient Sri Lankan civilization. It was 3rd capital of the Kingdom of Rajarata after Tambapanni and Upatissa Nuwara.

Jaya Sri Maha Bodhi is a sacred tree in the Mahamevna Gardens, Anuradhapura, Sri Lanka. It is the southern branch of the historical Sri Maha Bodhi at Buddha Gaya in India under which Buddha attained Enlightenment. It was planted in 288 BC, and is the oldest living human-planted tree in the world with a known planting date.

The Ruwanweli Maha Seya, also known as the Mahathupa (the Great Thupa) is a stupa (a hemispherical structure containing relics) in Anuradhapura, Sri Lanka. Two parts or one part of the Buddha's relics are enshrined in the stupa, making it the largest collection of his relics anywhere. It was built by Sinhalese King Dutugemunu in c. 140 B.C., who became king of Sri Lanka after a war in which the Chola King Elāra (Ellalan) was defeated.

spice garden is a popular tourist attraction in Sri Lanka where you can see how famous spices like cinnamon, pepper, cardamom, and cloves are grown naturally. Most spice gardens are located on the way from Dambulla to Kandy.

Then visit **Temple of theToothrelic**

Explore the sacred temple of the Tooth relic, a historic location on both cultural and religious significance.TheTempleoftheToothRelicisthejewelintheheartoftheoldcity,captivating

and majestic. It is a greatly venerated site as the place that holds the Tooth Relic of the Buddha andthusattractspilgrimsfromall

DAY 04:

KANDY – NUWARA ELIYA

Visit wood carving in kandy

Galle: For centuries Galle has stood strong against invasions - from colonial powers and nature's volatile outbursts. The famous Dutch Fort was first built by the Portuguese, fortified by the Dutch and preserved by the British. Battered daily for over 400 years by the ocean it even survived the onslaught of a tsunami and is enjoyed today by residents and visitors alike. The colonial architecture of the walled city too has resisted the advance of modernity and holds tightly to its past glory.
